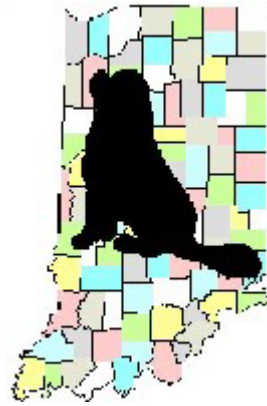

### LIMITED ENTRIES

Entries in this test will be limited to **12 Individuals or Teams**. A list of alternates will be kept in the order received if the limit is reached before the closing date. This test will not accept post entry of teams. Entries for requalification will be accepted if the entry limit is not filled by untitled dogs.

**A MINIMUM OF FIVE ENTRIES must be entered in order to hold this test.**

### ENTRIES ACCEPTED

Entries will be accepted by mail only and must be postmarked **SEPTEMBER 16, 2009 or later**. Entries postmarked prior to **SEPTEMBER 16, 2009** will be returned. Entry slots will be filled according to postmark date. In the event the number of entries with the same date received exceeds the limit, vacancies will be filled and alternates will be determined by random drawing. Entries received once the entry limit has been reached will be placed on an alternate list in order of postmark. Alternates will be notified immediately should an opening occur after the entry limit has been filled.

### ENTRIES CLOSE

Entries close at 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday, **OCTOBER 14, 2009** at the home of the Test Secretary, or before, if the entry limit is reached prior to the closing date. After that time, entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. ## ABOUT THE TEST SITE

Among the nation's largest city parks, Eagle Creek Park consists of 3100 acres of wooded terrain and open meadows surrounding 1300 acres of water. The Draft Test will be held at scenic Lilly Lake, a 5-acre pond, sequestered within the heart of the Park.

The maneuvering course is situated around the base of a grove of trees that opens onto a meadow overlooking Lilly Lake. The Basic Control exercises will be conducted on this small grassy meadow that overlooks the water. The freight haul begins on asphalt leading to a moderate downhill that ends several feet from the waterfront. This leads onto a foot trail. The foot trail circles the Lake, leading uphill along a packed hiking trail and winding through forest over wooded terrain. There are four bridges with the narrowest being 41½ inches wide. The longest bridge spans 24 feet.

Holding a Draft Test in an urban area presents some unique challenges. For example, Lilly Lake is a haven for joggers, hikers and fishermen as well as home to a variety of duck and geese. (Their droppings provide a tantalizing distraction!) Deer, raccoon, opossum and other wildlife are drawn to the area along with human visitors who choose this area to picnic. Eagle Creek is a public park and dogs, on leash are permitted entry. The Test Committee has no authority to prevent spectators accompanied by their dogs from visiting the area.

To insure the safety and comfort of our Newfs, Lilly Lake Shelter has been reserved and will serve as our central gathering point during the weekend. As guests of Eagle Creek Park, we ask that you clean up after your Newf whenever the need arises. May we also mention that according to law, alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the park.

### DIRECTIONS TO EAGLE CREEK PARK

Eagle Creek Park is located on the northwest side of Indianapolis with easy access from both I-465 and I-65. From I-70, I-74 or I-69 take I-465: If traveling northbound, take the 56th Street (#19) exit. At the stoplight, turn west onto 56th Street. The Park's entrance is one mile ahead on the right. If traveling southbound on I-465, take the 71st Street exit. At the stoplight, turn west onto 71st Street and follow it in to the Park.

From I-65: Take I-65 to I-465 to the 71st Street exit. At the stoplight, turn west onto 71st Street. Take 71st Street to the Park's entrance.

Entrance into the park is \$4.00 per day.

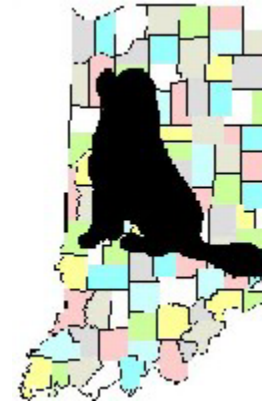

**DRAFT TEST DAY.....Sunday, October 25, 2009**

### **7:30 A.M. to 8:30 A.M.**

Hospitality Table opens at Lilly Lake Shelter. Breakfast is served. Handlers and dogs (except for bitches in season) are given 30-minutes to familiarize themselves with the Test Area. Handlers may walk the course with their dogs provided they are on-lead and are not hitched to a draft apparatus. Handlers are not permitted to walk the Maneuvering Course or the Freight Haul Course after this time.

### **7:30 A.M. to 8:00 A.M.**

Exhibitors required to check in with the Draft Test Secretary as provided for in the Draft Test Regulations. Exhibitors will receive numbered vests and ring favors at this time.

### **8:15 A.M.**

If an exhibitor has not checked in by this time, an "alternate" may be assigned the absent handler's position as provided for in the Draft Test regulations.

### **8:45 A.M.**

Judges meet with the exhibitors and stewards regarding the overall organization of the Test and instructions for Basic Control Exercises.

### **9:00 A.M.**

Draft Test begins with the Basic Control Exercises.

Judges meet with exhibitors and stewards regarding the next group of exercises: Harnessing/Hitching & Equipment Check, Basic Commands and Maneuvering Course.

Judges meet with exhibitors and stewards to organize for the last exercises: Freight Load and Distance Freight Haul.

Lunch will be at the Judges' discretion

Presentation of awards.

**ENTRY FEE**

The entry fee is \$35.00 for a single or team entry. Entries are limited to 12 either single or team dogs. Entries for re-qualification will be accepted and made available on a space available basis so as not to exclude any untitled dog.

**UNENTERED DOGS**

Because our Draft Test is being held in a public park, we cannot control the presence of spectator's dogs. Un-entered dogs, therefore, are welcomed provided they are kept quiet, on leash, or crated, and away from the designated Draft Test Areas.

**BITCHES IN SEASON**

Bitches in season will be allowed to compete after all other entries. They must be crated in the designated area away from the official test areas.

**EXHIBITORS NOTE**

Each exhibitor is responsible for providing his/her own draft equipment and proper freight load. This Draft Test will be judged using the NCA Draft Test Regulations effective Jan. 1, 2000.
